Meetings are held on the second Monday of every month at 7.30, at Stockbridge Parish Hall, and cover a wide range of topics likely to interest anyone who's keen on small unusual perennials as well as alpines, and there are always interesting plants for sale at bargain prices (from members' surplus propagation), and more if the speaker is a nurseryman who brings some of his own stock.

The next meetings are **Nov 10th** Saxifrages, **Jan 12th** Alpine Plants of south east France, **Feb 9th** Steve Bradley Bug Eat Bug (natural control of pests), **March 9th** Adventures in Yunnan, **April 13th** Patagonian Alpines (following the AGM).

On Saturday **14th March** the Annual Show is held (in the same hall as evening meetings, 2pm – 4pm) and there is also a plant sale.

The hall is on the corner of Stockbridge Gardens and Stockbridge Road, Donnington, nr Chichester PO19 8QT (from Chichester or the A27 take the A286 due south towards the Witterings, the hall is about half a mile on the right hand side of the road).
