Name	The Cottage Garden Society Kenneth Black Bursary
Purpose	The award was set up in memory of Kenneth Black in September 2011. It is available for horticultural purposes in connection with cottage gardens and/or cottage garden plants.
Amount of award	£750 The award can be topped up from other bursary funds if appropriate, provided all relevant recognition is given to The Cottage Garden Society
Limitations & Conditions	The successful applicant will be required to submit a detailed report on the completed project within three months of the end date of the work. This should include a financial breakdown of how the bursary was spent.
Eligibility	Primarily for horticulturist resident within the UK and Ireland to enable them to further their training and to broaden their skills, knowledge and experience.
